CAR PARK

The Congress Center has an indoor car park with a capacity for 180 vehicles and an outdoor carpark for 30 vehicles. The indoor car park level is below the Congress Center and has its entrance on the side of the Hilton Hotel.

Parking fees for the first hour Turkish Lira 4.000.000,- which is approx. EUR 2,60 and for each additional hour Turkish Lira 1.000.000,- (approx. EUR 0,65). Congress participants will only pay Turkish Lira 7.000.000,- maximum (approx. EUR 4,50) if they are able to show their Congress name badge.

Additionally the car park belonging to the Cemal Resit Rey Concert Hall which is located opposite the Congress Center can be used. Parking fees per hour Turkish Lira 3.500.000,- which is approx. EUR 2,20 and for 12 hours Turkish Lira 7.500.000,- (approx. EUR 4,75).

AIRPORT

All international and domestic flights arrive at Istanbul Ataturk Airport which is located 20 km from the Congress Venue and city center. Taxi fare from the airport to the city center is about EUR 25,00 – 30,00. Regular public bus transportation is also available from the airport to the city center (Taksim Region). It is easily recognizable by the "HAVAS" sign. A ride costs approx. EUR 10,00 per person and takes about 30 – 45 minutes to the city center.

There is no taxi station at the Congress Center. You can call taxis at the Registration Counter in the entrance area of the Rumeli Fair & Exhibition Hall or ask the security guards at the entrances to call a taxi for you.

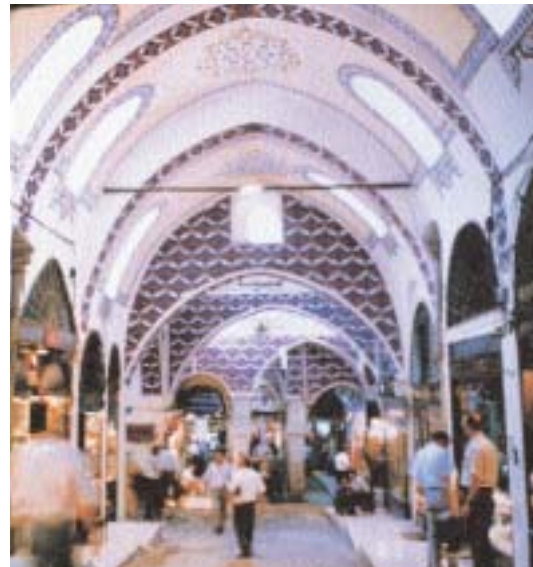

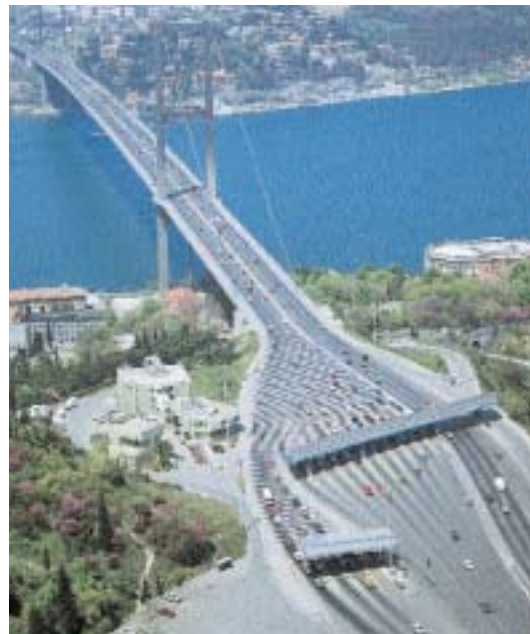
SIGHTSEEING TOUR FOR ACCOMPANYING PERSONS

STRUCTURE OF THE SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The scientific program is structured according to days. Each day starts with the sessions in the first time slot, continuing with the following time slots and ending with the last session at the end of the day. All presenters are listed by name and the title of their presentation.

STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT BOOK

The abstract book is structured by session format. The listing starts with a mixture of Podium Sessions and Moderated Poster Sessions according to days. Each day starts with the sessions in the first time slot, continuing with the following time slots and ending with the last session of this format at the end of the day. These sessions are followed by the poster abstracts.
