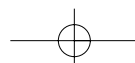
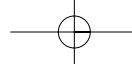

On behalf of the European Society for Sexual and Impotence Research (ESSIR) I would like to extend our cordial invitation to you to attend the 5th ESSIR Congress.

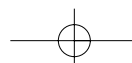
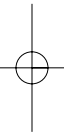

CME CREDITS

According to the rules of the committee for continuous medical education the German Association of Urology (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Urologie) in co-operation with the Professional Union of the German Urologists (Berufsverband der Deutschen Urologen) grants 6 points CME credits for confirmed attendance at national and international congresses per day except the last day where only 3 points are granted. That means that for attendance all 4 days of the ESSIR 2002 Congress a maximum of 21 CME points can be achieved. This applies for German Urologists. As currently no united rules in terms of CME credits exist for the European Union for each European country the respective medical professional associations have to be addressed separately.

INTRODUCTION TO THE SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

STRUCTURE OF THE SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The scientific program is structured according to days. Each day starts with the sessions in the first time slot, continuing with the following time slots and ending with the last session at the end of the day. All presenters are listed by name and the title of their presentation.

STRUCTURE OF THE SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The abstract book is structured by session format. The listing starts with a mixture of Podium Sessions and Moderated Poster Sessions according to days. Each day starts with the sessions in the first time slot, continuing with the following time slots and ending with the last session of this format at the end of the day. These sessions are followed by the poster abstracts.

TEACHING/LIVE SURGERY COURSES

The both Teaching Courses will last 180 or 150 minutes each, respectively the Live Surgery Course 330 minutes and present advances and the current state-of-the-art in clinically relevant topics. Courses are designed to provide learning experience. Attendees will be given the possibility to interact actively with the faculty of the course composed of well-known experts.

Courses are limited and registration will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

MASTER LECTURES

Each lecture will be given by a distinguished and honorable expert. These sessions, lasting 30 minutes, will be nominated by the Scientific Committee.

PODIUM SESSIONS

Podium Sessions will focus on special topics presenting the very recent findings in this field. Each session will last 60 minutes and consists of a maximum of 6 speeches per session.

ROUND TABLES

These sessions will usually last 90 minutes. They will focus on a particular topic and present the very recent data related to it. The round table will include a maximum of five papers and time for discussion.

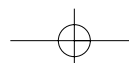
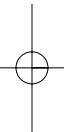

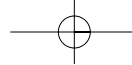

According to the rules of the committee for continuous medical education the German Association of Urology (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Urologie) in cooperation with the Professional Union of the German Urologists (Berufsverband der Deutschen Urologen) grants 6 points CME credits for confirmed attendance at national and international congresses per day except the last day where only 3 points are granted. That means that for attendance all 4 days of the ESSIR 2002 Congress a maximum of 21 CME points can be achieved. This applies for German Urologists. As currently no united rules in terms of CME credits exist for the European Union for each European country the respective medical professional
