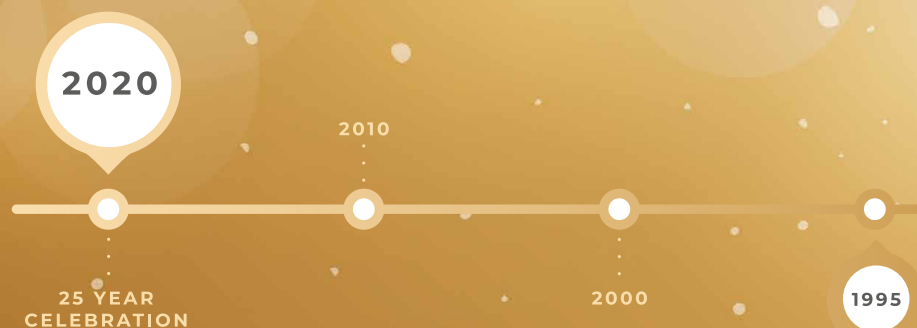

Debate

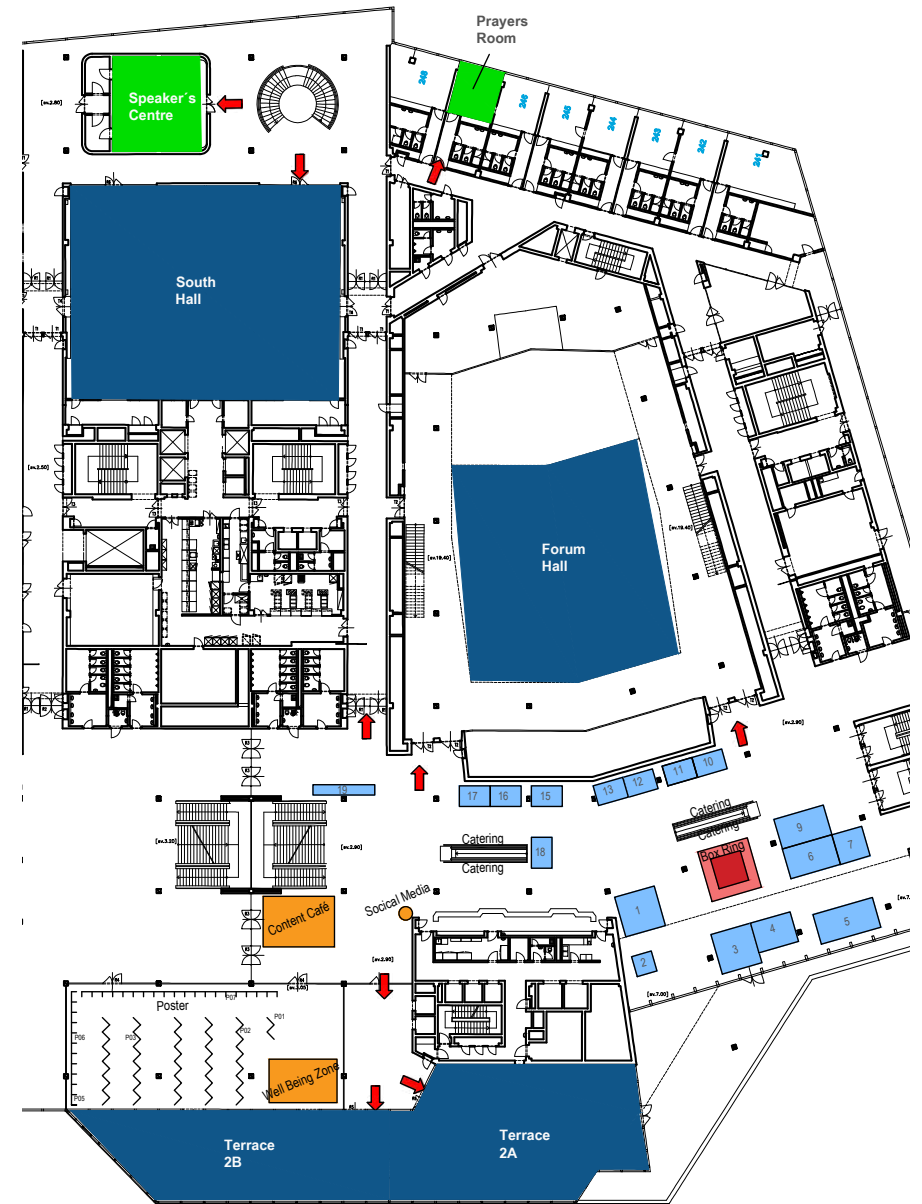
