

Johannes Bitzer is ex-chairman and Professor Emeritus of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University Hospitals Basel Switzerland.

He is a certified Obstetrician Gynecologist and is also trained in Psychotherapy and Behavioral Medicine.

He was President of the European Society of Contraception and Reproductive Health during 6 years and Former President of the International Society of Psychosomatic Obstetrics and Gynecology;

He serves as fellow for ISSWSH, member of Board of Directors of ISSM, Board member of the European Menopause and Andropause Society.

He is Director of the Diploma Course in Sexual Medicine/Sexual Therapy at the Advanced Study Center of the University of Basel, chairman of the Working Group in Education and Training of the European Collaboration in Science and Technology (COST).

His research and practical interest is in gynecologic endocrinology, sexual and reproductive health and the interface between obstetrics/gynecology and psychology / psychiatry with a special focus on education and training

He gave more than 300 invited lectures all over the world and published more 185 papers in peer reviewed journals. He is the Editor in Chief of the European Journal of Contraception and Reproductive Health and Associate Editor of the Journal of Sexual Medicine.
